Items We Cannot Accept:

- Anything prescribed by a medical provider
- Expired medications
- Open or unsealed over-the-counter medications
- Prescription medication
- Medications you are unsure how to dispose of
- Catheter supplies
- Tracheotomy supplies
- Oxygen tubing
- Oxygen tanks
- Tube feeding supplies
- Tube feeding cans of nutrition
- Hospital beds
- Expired items

Donations We Can Accept:

If you would like to support us, we gratefully accept unopened, in-date over-the-counter medications, such as Ibuprofen, Tylenol, and Naproxen, which are in high demand.
